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PREFACE

Various information related to students, faculty, stakeholders and people in general is published on the website regularly. The control of various Departments/Sections/ Offices is given to individual Heads/Office Bearers to update the contents of their respective web pages promptly. The Computer Center updates the information received from various departments/Sections of University at the earliest. The website is updated regularly with all information related to Admission, Recruitment, Events, E-Notice Board, Photo-Gallery, Students Activities etc. "Employee Search" facility is also available in our website for University Employees. Our website follows almost all the norms of Guidelines for Indian Government Websites (GIGW).

ERP : SAMARTH

SAMARTH is an e-Governance platform, developed under National Mission of Education in Information and Communication Technology Scheme (NMEICT) of M/o HRD. SAMARTH to enhance productivity through better information management in the institute by seamless access to information

Department of Higher Education, M/o Human Resource Development (now Ministry of Education), has mission to provide quality education to students across all Universities & HEIs. For this, Ministry of Human Resource and Development (now Ministry of Education) has developed an e-Governance platform, SAMARTH (Enterprises Resource Planning) ERP, under National Mission of Education in Information and Communication Technology Scheme (NMEICT). ERP, SAMARTH, is an Open Standard Open Source Architecture, Secure, Scalable and Evolutionary Process Automation Engine for Universities and Higher Educational Institutions. It caters to faculty, students and staffs at a University/Higher Educational Institutions. Now, the ERP, SAMARTH, has been implemented at Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (GGV). The objective of this initiative is to automate the processes of the Institute. Out of 45 Modules under SAMARTH, Organigram, Organisational Unit, User Management, Employee Management, RTI Management, Legal Case Management, Research Project Management, Examination Modules, Essential Services, Recruitment, Payroll, Leave Management, Minutes and Retrieval/ Document, Fee Management, Programme Management, Knowledge Management, Inventory Management, Bill Tracking System, Training and Placement, Security, Academic Management, Procurement of Goods, sports have been implemented in Guru Ghasidas



Vishwavidyalaya (GGV), the remaining are under process to implement.

This initiative will enhance the productivity through better information management in the institute by seamless access to information, and its utilization for various purposes.

For implementation of Samarth, meetings cum demonstration are conducted in online by Samarth Team at Delhi with the module owners/ admins and module coordinators at GGV. A number of Module Coordinators have been appointed to provide technical support to module owners/ admins who are literally the Officers –in- charge of various functions of University. For smooth functioning of Samarth at GGV, Prof AK Saxena, IT Cell Coordinator is appointed as the Coordinator of the Samarth Project whereas Dr Rohit Raja, Dr Amit Khaskalam and Dr Vinay Kumar Singh have been appointed as Assistant Coordinators of Samarth Project in GGV.

Online Meetings, Video Conferencing

Important National level webcast programmes were conducted time to time and IT Cell arranges to telecast those programmes to all students and staff at its campus. The video conferencing and other interactive events released by the Ministry of HRD and others are also conducted, where University authorities participated in the events. The existing NKN facility is used for the internet service. Besides these, time to time MHRD meetings, PMMMMNIT, HEFA in online meeting etc. are also conducted through video conferencing systems. Various Presentations related to internal as well as in online meetings are also performed through these facilities.

Internet and WiFi Services

The Internet and WiFi Services of Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur, campus was provided in the year of 2012 with 460 core nodes and 500+ internal connection (sub nodes). The network is made up of about 38 L2 Switches and 01 L3 Switches in this internet services. In the financial year 2021-22, 07 new buildings have also been connected with OFC cable so that in case of handover to the university, internet services can be provided in those new buildings also. Internet Services through NMEICT/NKN Project has been provided by Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya to all users in the campus with 01 Gbps speed and therefore, all users (Students, Faculties & Staff) are able to download their important / required documents from Websites, watch YouTube lectures or communicate to others at faster speed (1Gbps). It saves their valuable time. Using Internet Services University has been completed in Online Admission Policies, cashless transaction for fees & all other deposits, Video Conferencing, Telecast of the speeches of Hon'ble Visitor, The Prime Minister, The Minister of the Human Resources Development & other functions, Wi-Fi services successfully.

Wi-Fi: The Wi-Fi facility (MHRD) has been provided in the campus with good speed which saves users time. Wi-Fi services provided by The University with 280 AP (Access Point) free of cost to all the students, faculties & staff.
