A Brief Abstract of the Event (Maximum 500 Words):

7 Days NSS special camp of unit of IT (Institute of Technology) & UTD (University Teaching Department) of GGV was organized from 23.2.2018 to 01.3.2018 at village Tendubhata where 25 volunteers from unit of IT and 50 volunteers from unit of UTD took part in this camp.

The motto of the camp was '**NOT ME BUT YOU**' & '**BETI BACHAO BETI PARHAO**'. This expresses the essence of democratic living and upholds the need for selfless service. With this feeling, a group of 75 NSS volunteers started their journey towards village Tendubhata by University bus. It took around 02 hours to reach to Tendubhata. After reaching there, all NSS volunteers are allotted rooms in panchayat bhavan in Tendubhata. After that all the volunteers are distributed into 5 groups to conduct the entire NSS activity as well as camp activity with proper regulation. All the groups are engaged in preparation for inauguration ceremony. They created the stage, cleaned the ground, and decorated the campus using colored papers and posters.

During this 7 days duration, NSS volunteers took active part in various activities of the village for the welfare of the villagers and for understanding the village life and struggle in a better way. In the morning 'Shramdaan', volunteers **(1) repaired the broken roads of the village, (2) helped in the making the houses allotted to the villagers under the 'Pradhan mantra Awas Yojana', (3) worked for the beautification of the village by cleaning the ponds and making platform near pond, (4) cleaned the temples of the village, (5) did plantation in the temple ground and (6) took the classes of primary school and mixed with the students**



of the primary school. All these works were done under the constant vigilance of 'Sarpanch' Mr. Motilal Kanwar. NSS volunteers also conducted a rally in village to spread awareness among villagers regarding various social issues like – (a) cleanliness mission, (b) Beti Bachao Beti Padhao. During the camp 'swachhta Rath' arrived in the village. Village Tendubhata is declared as the ODF village. One day during the camp a meeting with villagers was also organized in which NSS volunteers were also invited. The volunteers expressed their opinion on the importance and benefits of the cleanliness and ODF and motivated the villagers towards these activities.

In the evening during '**Gram Sampark activity (village relation)**', some of the volunteers did the survey in the village Tendubhata. During the survey it was observed that the village is self-dependent. Villagers are aware about the government schemes and are getting benefitted with various schemes like- 'Ujjwla Yojana', 'Atal Awas Yojana' and other government schemes. Village Tendubhata is adopted by the university. Time to time visit of 'Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan' team used to organize here and they used to make their efforts for the development of the village in different social aspects. Volunteers also did afternoon play with the village children and played the NSS games and mingled with them.

As part of the camp activities, volunteers also organized the 'Brain Storming session' in the afternoon session. The guest speakers (1) Prof. Manisha Dubey delivered speech on the 'Life of Vivekanand' and 'Personality Development', (2) Prof. Manish Srivastava talked on the 'Importance of the self-discipline', (3) Dr. K.K. Chandra, Nodal officer of 'Unnat Bharat Abhiyan' spoke about the 'Significance of the Village Life' and 'How should volunteers behave during the camp'. And further time to time, other program officers- Dr. Ramesh Gohe, Dr. Devendra Patel, Dr. Archana Kumari visited the camp and discussed on various issues. On the other days, NSS volunteers continued the brain storming session and discussed different social issues what they need to survey and need to motivate the villagers. A report on 'village Tendubhata' based on their survey is under preparation after proper analysis.

During various programs in the camp stage anchoring is managed by volunteers chetan kumar, Kishor Kumar, Surya prakash Pali and others. The volunteer Shivakant Mishra guided the students during the morning exercise and yoga. And the various activities of the camp were planned, managed and executed by the experienced supervision of Program officers Dr. Namita Sharma and Dr. Soma Das. Students also published hand-written newsletter of the camp named '**Tendubhata Jagaran**' everyday in the morning where they expressed their feelings, love and experience during these camp activities.

In the evening after the dinner at 8.00pm, the volunteers used to arrange cultural activities in the camp site where villagers used to come to visit and enjoy. Some village kids also performed on stage during the cultural activities. In one evening, the volunteers showed the movie 'Dangal' on projector to convey the message to promote girls of the village.
