Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya is named after Saint Guru Ghasidas (1756-1836), a visionary social reformer. Guru Ghasidas founded Satnam Panth, a socio-religious sect, which challenged contemporary discriminatory social order and advocated for social equality by refuting the exploitative and hierarchical caste system. With his holistic vision and systematic reforms, Guru Ghasidas contributed significantly in removing the prevailing social injustice and inequality.

Satnam Panth believes that truth is God and there is only one God, which is formless (nirgun) and infinite (anant). Individual reformation was brought by prohibiting consumption of liquor and non-vegetarian food. Guru Ghasidas also formulated principles, which show his love for fauna and his desire to put an end to cruelty towards animals. The partisans of Satnam Panth have been following these dictates from last hundreds of years now.

After its upgradation into a central university, many steps have been taken by the University authorities to translate Guruji's philosophy into reality. Now, our campus is an alcohol and tobacco free campus. Our vibrant university campus, where students from diverse castes, creeds and classes come together from all over India, provides an egalitarian environment based on Guruji's teachings.



ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (GGV), a Central University established by the Central Universities Act 2009 of the Parliament, was originally established as State University by an Act of State Legislative Assembly of the then undivided Madhya Pradesh on 16th June 1983. GGV is an active member of the Association of Indian Universities and Association of Commonwealth University. The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) has accredited the University as B.

Situated in a socially and economically challenged area, the University is appropriately named to honour the great Satnami Saint Guru Ghasidas (born in 17th century), who championed the cause of the downtrodden and waged a relentless struggle against all forms of social evils and injustice prevailing in the society.




The University is a semi-residential institution. The University covers almost the total spectrum of higher education in 32 numbers of university teaching departments offering various courses in the areas of Arts, Commerce, Education, Engineering and Technology, Humanities, Life Sciences, Management, Pharmacy, Sciences and Social Sciences. The lush green sprawling campus of the University spread over an area of aprox. 655 acres is located 05 KM away from the main Bilaspur City, in Koni village. River Arpa, the lifeline of Bilaspur, runs parallel to the University campus. Bilaspur is a fast Industrializing City, already having a large number of industrial units coming up in the region. The area is the nerve center of trade in iron and steel, coal, aluminium, textiles, foodgrains, 'Kosa' silk, cement, paper, furniture and jewellery and is internationally known for its rice production.

The University aims at disseminating and advancing knowledge by providing instructional and research facilities in various branches of learning. Facilities for the students

Campus

- The greenest, bio - aesthetic exquisite campus enriched with clean and fresh environment spreads over an area of 655 acres.
- Along with the scholarly ambience, the campus also comprises of extra- academic facilities needed for the enhancement of all-round development of the students.

Library

- Nucleus of Academics our Well-Stocked Library located in main campus caters the needs and exigencies of the students, teachers and Research scholars.
- The cavernous building can accommodate more than 500 people at a time and inventory of 128000 books, 400 back volume of journals, 1500 Ph.D. thesis.
- Internet and Wi-Fi services is also free of cost.
- UGC Info net and INDEST consortia services are also made available.



Computer Centre

- The University has modernized computer centre with several versions of Linux and Windows operating systems to compliment computer literacy.
- A large number of peripherals such as printers, LCD projectors, scanners and other multimedia devices are handy for users.
- The internet connection is provided to all.
- It also maintains University website www.ggu.ac.in (250 web pages) which provides all the relevant information and notifications regarding the university's happenings.

Women's Studies Development Centre

- Women's Studies development centre is the first centre of Women's Studies development in the state and was entrenched in 2005.
- The centre concentrates on the raising consciousness and knowledge of gender equality and equity issues through participatory activities



Training and Placement Cell

- It's backed by School placement cells which aims to act as an association between industry and the university.
- The cell takes care of all the activities to make the students employable and self-reliable.
- Recently, many companies/Industries having International dignity like TCS, Sake Solutions Wipro BPO Satyam Services Private Limited have recruited are bright scholars.

Proctorial Board

- The university has constituted a Proctorial Board for keeping its campus well disciplined.
- The Board takes prompt action in case of any misconduct if occurs in the campus and recommends appropriate punishment for students found guilty.
- It also takes all the preventive measures against ragging and examines the cases of alleged ragging (if any).
- All the students are required to submit an undertaking to the proctorial board as not to be involved in any type of misconduct at the time of admission.



Facilities for the Students

Hostel Facilities

- Four hostels, three for boys and one for girls separately, provide accommodation to 800 approx boys and 430 girls. Two more girls Hostels of capacity 200 will be available very soon for allotment.
- Vishwavidyalaya faculty member as Warden supervises each hostel.
- The university aims to provide a comfortable lodging and boarding services to the students keeping in view a home away from the home.
- Admission in hostels is based on merit as per university rules and the students will be required to apply in the prescribed application form.
- In view of the limited hostel facilities available, the candidates may please note that the grant of admission to a course of a study in the UTD would not automatically entitle one for allotment of hostel accommodation and that the application of the students for Hostel allotment will be considered if seats in the hostel are available.
- Hostel residents are expected to observe the rules and regulations prescribed for them as well as all the requirements of corporate life and the social norms that living together demands.
- Failure to observe discipline or violation of rules may make a student liable to disciplinary action which may result in the withdrawal of Hostel Facilities.

1. For admission in Girl's Hostel and Swami Vivekanand Boy's Hostel

- Hostel Fee Rs. 8750.00 (Rs. 6750.00 Yearly + Rs. 2000.00 Refundable Hostel Caution Money) to be deposited in the University General Account
- Mess Fees Rs. 12070.00 (Rs. 8070.00 Mess Charges for three months + Rs. 4000.00 Refundable Caution Money) to be deposited in the Hostel Mess Account.

2. For Admission in New Hostels

- Hostel Fee Rs. 12000.00 (Rs. 10000.00 Yearly + Rs. 2000.00 Refundable Hostel Caution Money) to be deposited in the University General Account
- Mess Fees Rs. 12070.00 (Rs. 8070.00 Mess Charges for three months + Rs. 4000.00 Refundable Caution Money) to be deposited in the Hostel Mess Account.



Jawahar Atithi Griha

- The Vishwavidyalaya Guest House, located amidst lush green surrounding and pollution free environment, has 16 well-furnished and air-conditioned rooms to provide comfortable stay to visitors to the Campus at a reasonable charge.

Forestry Guest House

- The Forestry Guest House was established with a grant-in-aid received from Indian Council for Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE), Dehradun.
- It has 31 rooms, the guest house is surrounded by different forest tree species.
- The guest house provides temporary accommodation to visiting teachers, research scholars, students and participants of various conferences, seminars and training programmes

New International Guest House

- The International Guest House is constructed with a grant-in-aid from UGC XI plan.
- It is new building with G+2 floors. It has five VIP suites, 38 rooms, one party hall and Gymnasium.
- It is located at the elevated southern area of campus and surrounded by the lush green area.



Facilities for the students

Residential Facility for Employees

- The University extends residential facility to its employees.
- Presently, there are 233 staff quarters for different categories of Teaching/Non-Teaching staff of the University.
- The staff colony is very well connected by roads with well-lit avenues.
- The colony is surrounded by lush green trees and has a pleasant environment.
- A 'Kali' temple built near the quarters provides a space for peaceful meditation and for occasional social celebrations.

Cafeteria

- New Cafeteria Building with G+1 floor was constructed with grant-in-aid from UGC XI plan.
- It is situated behind university auditorium.
- It has one big cafe-seating hall of 25m x 16m at ground floor.
- The Cafeteria is successfully catering to the daily needs of the university community.
- The Cafeteria remains open on all working days from 8.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m.

Health Centre

- Health facilities are available for students and residents of the campus under the able guidance of a Medical Officer and other visiting specialist, as per needs.
- Specialist from CIMS also visit the health center in the campus from time to time for specialized checkup & advice.

Student Creativity Centre

- University has developed Student Creativity Centre in which various types of facilities including indoor games such as table tennis, Chess etc are available.
- Entertainment facilities and leisure time reading magazines are kept for the personality development of the students during their off time.
- The centre is run and maintained by the constituted student council under the supervision of Dean, Students welfare.

Tarang- The University Musical Band

- It is the university's musical band which is a student managed group.
- Every year, 09 students is recruited in the group.

Udaan-The Official Student Magazine

- The Official annual magazine of the university "Udaan" is made and managed by the students.
- It gives a platform to the creative minds of the university as well as contributes to the overall development of its members.
- It helps them to grow skills and enhance their creativity.

Urchins-University's Theatre and Nukkad Play Group

- "Urchins" is the theatre and nukkad play group of this university, which is well-known in entire Chhattisgarh.
- It presents its programs on state level and is also engaged in the effort to advance the level of theatre.

Abhitan- University's Dance Group

- It is a special platform to provide the opportunity to the students having interest in dancing.
- In the six year of its journey the group has proved itself on intra and inter-university level competitions and presentations, full of classical and semiclassical and folk dance specials.



Facilities for the students

Auditorium

- The campus has fully developed Auditorium with a seating capacity of about 800 audiences.

Gymnasium

- Well-equipped and ultra modern gymnasium has been established in the campus for students.

Sports Centre

- The University has fully furnished Sports Centre to promote athletic expertise of youth.

Equal Opportunities Cell

- As per UGC during XI plan, University has coaching facilities for SC/ST, minorities, OBC and other weaker section students. Coachings presently running in the campus are:
 - NET coaching scheme
 - Remedial coachingscheme
 - Entry level coaching scheme.

Post Office and Bank

- Punjab National Bank, Bank of India and Post Office Koni are rendering their services in the campus.
- ATM facilities by PNB is available in the campus.
- A new electronic telephone exchange is also established in the campus

Psychological Counselling Centre

- As per guidelines of the MHRD, Govt. of India and State Govt. of Chhattisgarh, State Mental Health Hospital, Sendri, Bilaspur under the National Mental Health programme, the university has established the Psychological Counselling Centre on 29th November 2016.

SC/ST Cell

- As per UGC guidelines, the university possesses a separate SC/ST cell which processes and provides assistance to the SC/ST students.

National Service Scheme (NSS), National Cadet Corp (NCC)

- The NSS/NCC targets to inculcate the spirit and provide working experience for social services through various team-building activities.

Grievance Redressal Mechanism

- The University has its own Grievance Redressal Mechanism. The University has constituted many committees which are redressing the grievances received from students and employees.
- To redress grievances related to sexual harassment, the University has constituted Internal Complaint Committee (ICC). Similarly for redressal of grievances related to students, the University has constituted Grievance Redressal Committees also.
- The University Administration has provided Complaint Box in its campus to the students and employees. Students or employees can drop their complaints or feedbacks in these boxes.



Code of Conduct for Students

The students are admitted to Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya to achieve excellence and shape their character to become responsible citizens. They must realize their responsibility towards the Vishwavidyalaya and to its components like faculty, staff and fellow students. Failure to maintain a good standard of conduct shall result in disciplinary action.

Attendance: 75% attendance is compulsory in each subject

Misconduct:

Any of the following activities (but not limited to these only) will be treated as misconduct.

- Disruption of teaching activities or disturbing the learning process of other students on the campus.
- Any act on the part of the students, which disrupts functioning of the university, endangers health and safety of campus residents and damages Vishwavidyalaya properties.
- Cheating in examination and supplying of false documents / information in order to seek any consideration / favour from the University.
- Possession or consumption of intoxicating beverages on the campus.
- Failure to return back loaned material, settle University dues.
- Possession of weapons.
- Use of unparliamentary language while in conversation with Vishwavidyalaya Staff and fellow students.

Disciplinary Actions:

Failure to adhere to good conduct may result in disciplinary actions like:

- A warning by the authorities.
- Suspension from a particular class.
- Suspension / expulsion from the University.
- Suspension of campus privileges e.g. hostel, accommodation etc.
- Withholding of examination result or withdrawal of awarded diploma / degree certificate.
- Any other disciplinary action deemed appropriate by the University authorities.

1.	Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur invites online applications for admission to the various programmes for the academic session 2022-23 through Common University Entrance Test CUET (UG) 2022 to be conducted by NTA.
2.	For Foreign Nationals policy of admission is attached separately.
3.	Guidelines for submission of online application form as notified by NTA are available separately. It is suggested to the applicants that before submitting online application forms read the instructions carefully. Mere appearance in the CUET 2022 or inclusion of name in the merit list does not entitle a candidate to be considered for admission to a course unless he/she fulfils the prescribed eligibility conditions for that programme.
4.	Age should not be more than 22 years for Under Graduate Programmes and 25 years for Post Graduate Programmes , B.P.Ed, B.Lib. & Inf.Sc. and Diploma Programmes as on 1-July-2022. For M.Pharm and M.Lib. & Inf.Sc. Programmes, the upper age limit is 27 years. For M.P.Ed. Programme, the upper age limit is 28 years. There will be no upper age limit for B.Ed. & M.Ed./BA-LLB/B. Com LLB Programmes.
5.	Date of Entrance Test, Test method, Application fee, Entrance Test centre, Admission procedure etc. will be notified by National Testing Agency (NTA) from time to time and the same may be uploaded on the University website www.ggu.ac.in . Therefore, it is suggested to all applicants that they have to visit NTA website, CUET 2022 links and www.ggu.ac.in regularly.
6.	Jurisdiction: All disputes related to admission in Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya particularly will be subject to Bilaspur jurisdiction only.
