Summary Report

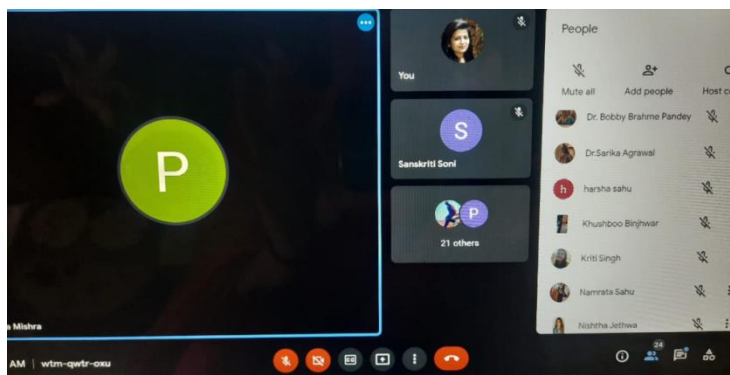
Department of Management Studies celebrated **Swachhta Pakhwada** through online mode for creating awareness among the students and to make them learn about the importance of cleanliness.
