World Environment Day

World Environment Day was celebrated at Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur on 5th June 2022. The theme of the day was "only one earth". Honourable Vice Chancellor Prof. Alok Chakrawal presided the event and Chief Guest was Shri Rajesh Kumar Chandelle, Chief Conservator of Forest, Bilaspur Circle. Other guests grace their presences were Registrar Prof. Shailendra Kumar, Deans of different Schools, Head of the Departments, Finance Officer Prof. S. C.
