

A Brief Abstract of the Event (Maximum 500 Words):

Pedagogical and Assessment Issues in Teacher Education

The ICSSR sponsored, two-day national seminar on *Pedagogical and Assessment Issues in Teacher Education* began with the Inaugural session at RajatJayantisabhagar of Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur in which Dr. C.S. Vazalwarwelcomed the gathering. The Dean of social sciences, Prof. AnupamaSaxena showered her blessings and conveyed best wishes for the successful completion of the seminar then after, the chief guest Prof. ShashikalaWanjari, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of the SNDT women's University, Mumbai deliveredkey note address. Presidential address was given by Prof. Anjila Gupta, the Vice Chancellor of GGV. At the end Dr. Sonia Sthapak, the Convenor of the seminar, conferred the vote of thanks.

After the inaugural programme two plenary sessions were organized at new cafeteria building of GGV. In first plenary session Prof. Ramesh Babu gave his thoughts on policy perspectives related to teacher education, he also told about paradigm shift in schooling. Moderators of this session were Dr. Paul Pudussery and Dr. J. Vijaypurkar. In second plenary session Dr. H. Sarangi conveyed his knowledge about

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contemporary perspectives in teacher education, and the moderators for this session were Prof. R. Babu and Prof. S. Gupta. After the plenary sessions lunch was served.

After lunch *parallel* technical sessions were organized for oral and poster presentations on different themes of seminar. There were total forty nine Posters and five oral presentations. The posters were based on different themes of the seminar, viz., ICT, challenges in teacher education, quality in teacher education, significance of open and distance mode in teacher education etc.
