Hence, the department proposes an activity for developing effective reading cards for upper primary level students by experts, school teachers, teacher educators and B.1.1 trained teacher-educator experts. Under the Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT) scheme of MHRD, the department organized development and distribution of reading cards in English for upper primary level to extend its support for the children of the school children of the state. The whole project will be covered throughout the year and the second workshop is being organized at this second phase on the proposed date for developing reading materials on different themes.</p>	<p>Concepts of Reading Cards The set of structured reading cards is not only an imaginative but exciting. A reading card is designed from a book or still has a readable text in terms of shape, size, colour and content. The enjoyable stories and cartoons illustrated presented in a creative language format are found to motivate the young learners and improve their reading skills. The cards are specifically designed for independent or self-paced reading. Each reading card contains a complete self-contained text. The texts are made engaging with passages on people, places, science, folklore, and stories from real life and mythology with lively and imaginative illustrations to accompany them. At the end of the text simple comprehension, grammar and vocabulary exercises enable self-evaluation.
