The GATE 2018 score is calculated using the formula

$$\text{GATE Score} = S_1 + (S_2 - S_1) \frac{(M - M_1)}{(M_0 - M_1)}$$

where,

- M is the marks obtained by the candidate in the paper (involved) on this GATE 2018 scorecard
- M_1 is the qualifying marks for general category candidate in the paper
- M_0 is the score of marks of top 0.1% (or top 10 (whichever is larger)) of the candidates who appeared in the paper (in case of multi-session papers including all sessions)
- $S_1 = 300$, is the score assigned to M_1
- $S_2 = 900$, is the score assigned to M_0

In the GATE 2018 score formula, M is 75 marks (out of 100) or $\mu + \sigma$, whichever is greater (Here μ is the mean and σ is the standard deviation of marks of all the candidates who appeared in the paper).

Qualifying in GATE 2018 does not guarantee either an admission to a post-graduate program or a scholarship/scholarship. Admitting institutes may conduct further tests and interviews for final selection.
