The GATE 2019 score is calculated using the formula

$$GATE\ Score = S_1 + (S_2 - S_1) \frac{(M - M_0)}{(M_1 - M_0)}$$

where,
 M is the marks obtained by the candidate in the paper, mentioned on this GATE 2019 scorecard
 M_1 is the qualifying marks for general category candidate in the paper
 M_0 is the mean of marks of top 0.1% or top 10 (whichever is larger) of the candidates who appeared in the paper (in case of multi-session papers including all sessions)
 $S_1 = 35$, is the score assigned to M_1
 $S_2 = 90$, is the score assigned to M_0

In the GATE 2019 score formula, M_1 is 25 marks (out of 100) on $\mu + \sigma$, whichever is greater. Here μ is the mean and σ is the standard deviation of marks of all the candidates who appeared in the paper.

Qualifying in GATE 2019 does not guarantee either an admission to a post-graduate program or a scholarship/award/scholarship. Admitting institutes may conduct their own steps and processes for final selection.
