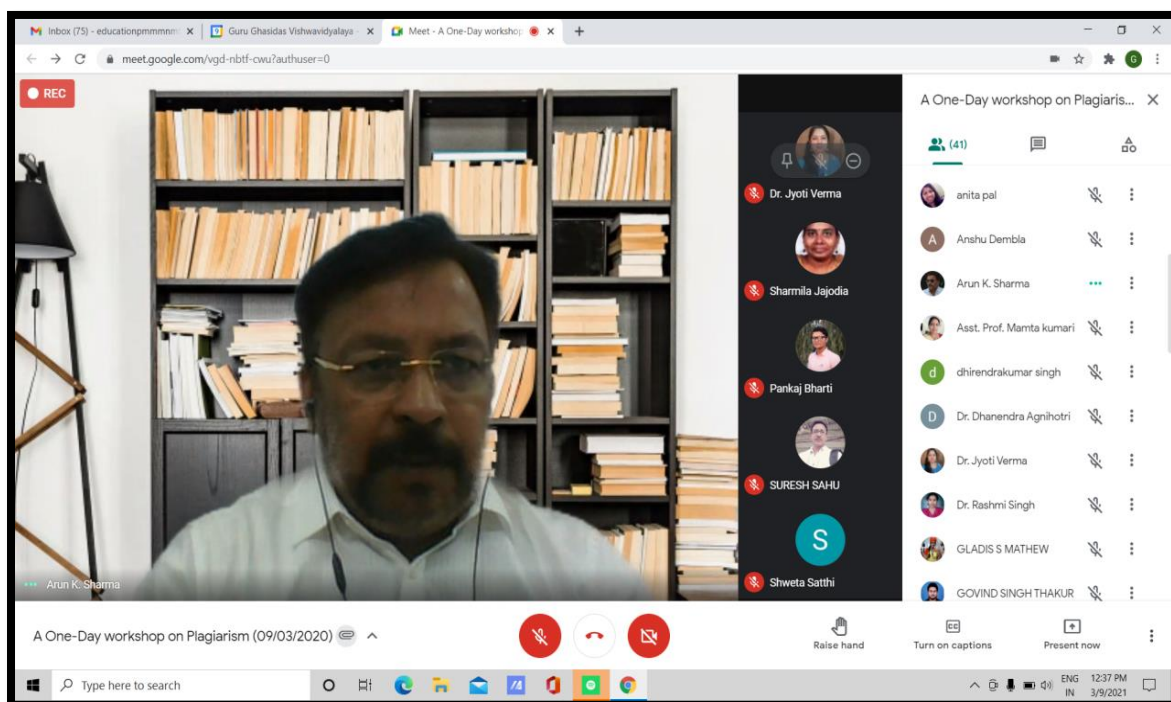

### **A Brief Abstract of the Event**

Department of Education, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh has organised a one-day online workshop on “Plagiarism (Phase-I)” on 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2021. The Convener of the workshop was Dr. C. S. Vazalwar, Head and Associate Professor, Department of Education, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur (C.G.), and Dr. Sambit Kumar Padhi, Assistant Professor, Department of Education, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur (C.G.) and Dr. Jyoti Verma, Assistant Professor, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur (C.G.) were the coordinators of the workshop. The workshop was organized through google meet.

The objectives of the workshop were -1) Write and publish good-quality research works; 2) Identify and report the unethical practices and misconduct in research; 3) Improve the quality of research and publication. The participants of the workshop were faculty members of higher education and research scholars. A total of 63 participants have participated in the workshop. Session I & II (03 hours) was taken by Dr. A. K. Sharma, Librarian, Central Library, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur and he discussed the research integrity and types of plagiarism, and taken up few hands-on activities with Urkund software. Further, session III & IV (03 hours) was taken by Dr. Pramod Kumar Gupta, Assistant Professor, RIE, Bhubaneswar and he discussed the types of plagiarism, avoiding plagiarism in the dissertation writing. He also conducted few hands-on activities with some other plagiarism checking software. All 63 participants were awarded the certificate of participation.
