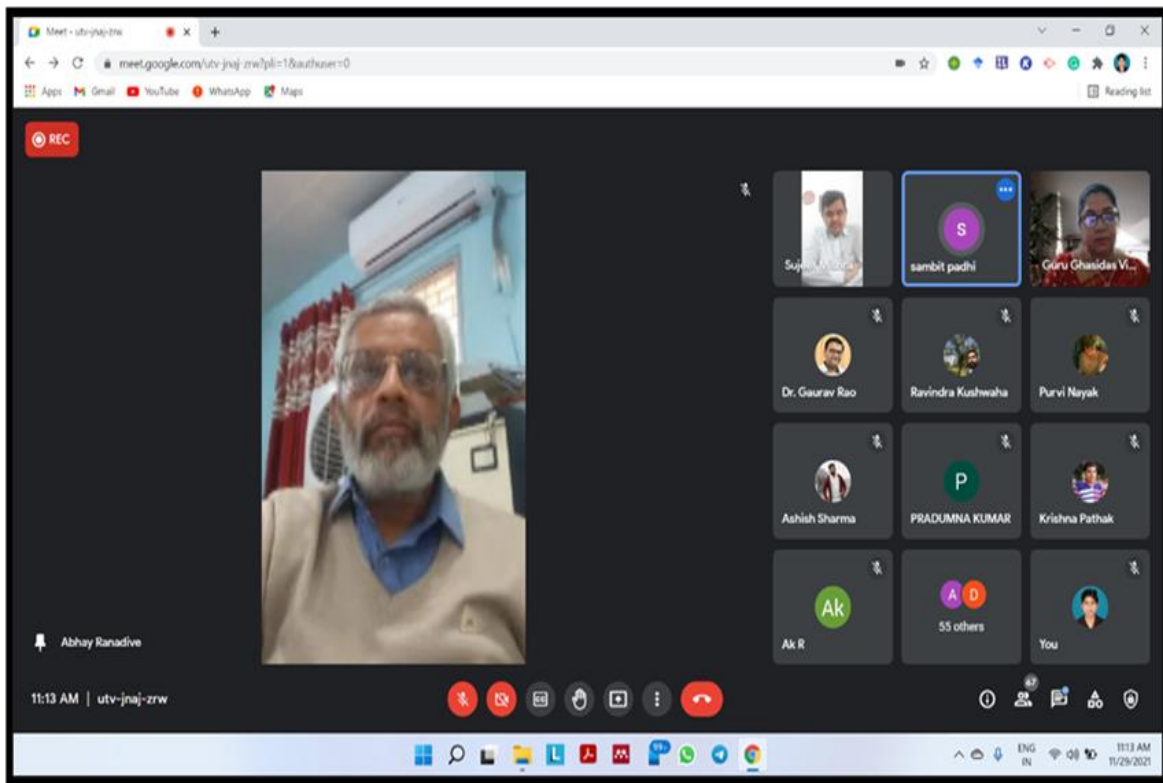

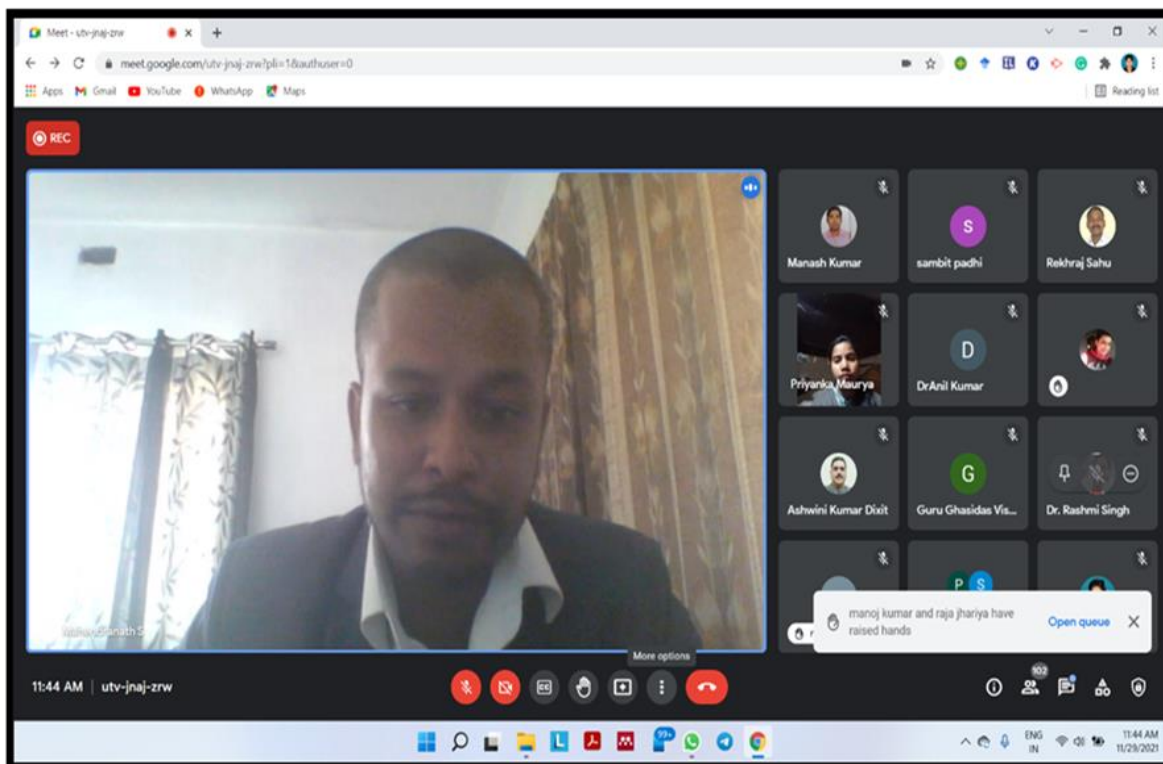
### **A Brief Abstract of the Event:**

A one-day online webinar on “*Conceptual Plagiarism in Contemporary Research*” was organized by the Department of Education, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (A Central University) Bilaspur (C.G.) on November 29, 2021. The program started at 11:00 am through google meet. At first, the coordinator of the programme Dr. Jyoti Verma, welcomed all the guests and participants of the programme. The coordinator of the webinar ,Dr. Sambit Kumar Padhi, Senior faculty member of Department of Education, welcomed the chief guest and introduced the theme, objective and purpose of the webinar. The guest of the programme was Dr. Sujeet Kumar, Head & Associate Professor, Department of Education, GGV, Bilaspur. He encouraged and congratulated the organizing team of the webinar and welcomed the participants. The Chief Guest of the Webinar was Prof. A. S. Ranadeve, Director IQAC, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur. Around 149 participants joined in the inaugural session of the webinar among them most of them are young research scholars. After the inaugural session, webinar session started at 11:30 AM in which the resource person of the webinar was Mr. Mahendrnath Sarkar, Trainer & Develop, Informatics Publication Ltd. Bangalore. During his presentation , he narrated the incidents of conceptual plagiarism with relevant examples. He also explained the tips and tricks to avoid this type of unethical practices in research work. He suggested that proper referencing and bibliography management is need of the hour and each and every researcher must use the plagiarism tools and bibliography management software in his/her research work . He mentioned that in the process of research, role of supervisor is very crucial. He/she must ensure that their research scholar follow the ethical guidelines of the research work and needs to avoid plagiarism in the research work. At the end of the session, question and answer session was organized and research scholars interacted with resource person to clear their confusion and query.
