

## Economics Deptt of GGU organises virtual discussion on 'Post Budget Discussion-2022'

AN ENLIGHTENING virtual discussion session 'Post Budget Discussion-2022' was organised in the Department of Economics of Guru Ghasidas Central University (GGU) here. More than a hundred intellectuals participated in this programme organised under the guidance of Vice-Chancellor Professor Alok Kumar Chakrawal.

At the outset, Vice Chancellor Alok Kumar Chakrawal welcomed all the guests and briefly highlighted the main points of the budget.

In the virtual discussion, speaker Professor Mohammed Muzarrmil presented his views and told in particular the main points of the budget and said that this budget besides leading to sustainable development, will also give impetus to the goal of quality education and startups. Co-operatives and their works have also been promoted in this budget.

Vice Chancellor of Atal Behari Bajpai University (ABBU), Professor ADN Bajpai said in his address that this budgeted will serve as a base for the next 25 golden years.

In the Budget 2022-2023, the development of infrastructure such as construction of 25000 kilometer of high-ways, pollution free 400 new generation Vande Bharat Trains services, One Class One TV Channel, PME Vidya Solar Energy Development, 80 Lakh Accessible Houses and moving towards digitisation with cent percent availability of fiber optics in rural areas, linking post offices and banks Under Financial Inclusion Development is envisaged.

In view of the circumstances arising out of the current global pandemic, health has been given the highest priority. He said that creation of infrastructure will create employment through backward linkage and forward linkage. The programme was convened by Professor Manisha Dubey and the vote of thanks was proposed by Dr Ravindra Sharma.
