
During the course of her internship she attended Court Proceedings and Arbitration Proceedings. She also attended client conferences and conducted research work on:

- **Civil Procedure:** Liability of Attesting Witness towards contents of legal deed or agreement; discovery of documents under Order 11 Rule 12 and 21 ; whether the tribunal has the power to request the third party to produce the documents to the court or not.
- **Hong Kong's Law of Arbitration:** Researched on the Hong Kong's Law of Novation.
