INTRODUCTION

The Department of Political Science was established in 1987 as a teaching department of Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur (Chhattisgarh). 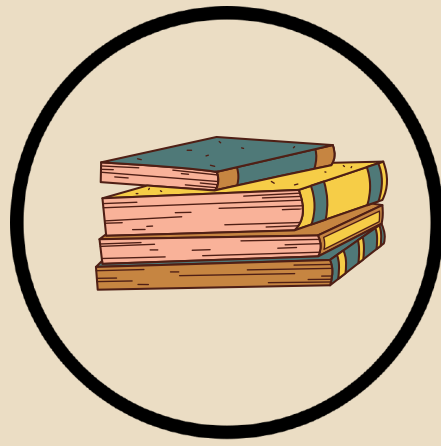

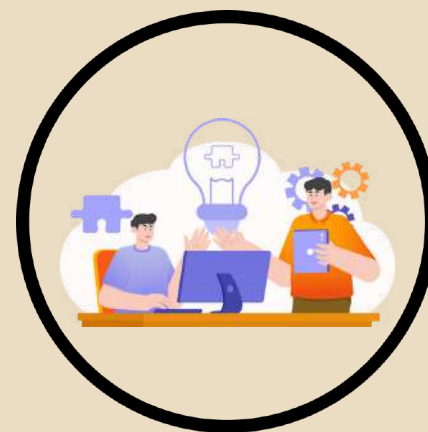

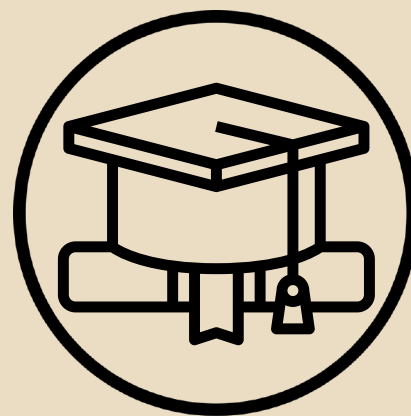
