GATE IN A NUTSHELL: A BEGINNER'S GUIDE FOR SUCCESS

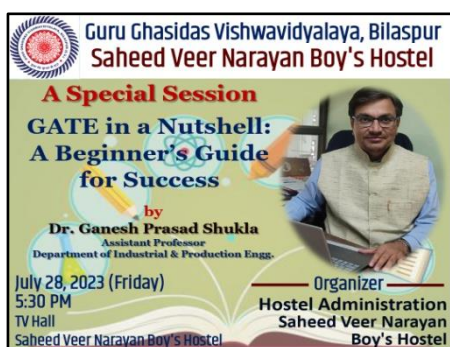
