On Saturday, 28th of August, 2021, a career guidance talk titled, “Samvaad” was organized by the Department of Mechanical engineering, School of studies in Engineering and Technology, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (Central University), Bilaspur. It was conducted by Dr. Prof. T. V. Arjunan who is the Dean (SoS, E&T), and Mrs. Shweta Singh who is an Asst. Professor in the Department of Mechanical Engineering.

The webinar started at 11:00 AM where Prof. T. V. Arjunan (Dean, SoS, E&T) welcomed the chief Speakers, faculty members, and students. A brief introduction about the speakers was given by Mrs. Shweta Singh, assistant professor in Mechanical Engineering.
