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A Brief Abstract of the Event (Maximum 500 Words):

The purpose of the workshop was to provide information about medicinal plants that are used to prepare herbal drugs. The Outcome Mapping workshop took place over three (3) days from 20/10/2016 to 22/102016. Some sessions within the workshop were held at herbal garden, RTSD department GGV Bilaspur and herbal product manufactured unit Dongarnala, Pali, Bilaspur. On the first day of workshop after inauguration there was small medicinal plant exhibition for some 30 medicinal important plants mostly from C.G. region with their high demand in herbal drug industry for participants. The lecture was delivered by Prof V.D. Rangari on Herbal drug development issue for medicinal plant based products, Along with basic ideas about herbal drug; he gave detailed information about-how we can utilize medicinal plant for the product development. The practical session was also conducted by Dr. MP Shahi for participants, their they learned the techniques of extraction of some therapeutically important secondary metabolites with soxhlet apparatus, Clevenger apparatus, and chemical extraction. In this session students came to know about extraction and preliminary phytochemical testing of medicinal plants therapeutically important secondary metabolites such as flavanoid, tannins, saponins, terpenoids. On the second day, field trip was organized by Dr. SK Shahi, Botany Department for understanding the growing habits of the different medicinal plants such as Ashk, Giloi, Hadjad, Sarpganda, Satavari, Akash Neem, Acorus, and many more and their uses in different medicinal uses. The lecture was also conducted by Dr. DVSK Kaladhar, he provided information on the insilico techniques and bioinformatics uses towards herbal drug development, protein targeted and different aspects of research in the field of herbal drug development to enhance the standardization of herbal drug by application of new and advance technology for successful entrepreneurship. Furthermore, Dr. Deepandra Singh, provided knowledge about data representation on herbal drug industry and systematic approach in this field.

During last day, lecture was delivered by Dr. Nirmal Awasthi on medicinal plant based herbal drug their development, cultivation and problem related to their maintenance and application in different plant species of economic importance and the scope of it's as a herbal medicinal product. After the final lecture a field was organized for the participants to herbal product manufacturing Unit Dongarnala, Pali, Bilaspur for understand collection, selection, preservation and herbal drug formulation units their registration and planning strategies for small scale industry in this field the different application strategies of herbal drug industry in the Cg and for our nation. At last, students from different departments of G.G.V and Bilaspur University learned about the use and production of herbal drug, isolation, purification, and maintenance of medicinal plants, the mass production and formulation, in addition to the instructions for field application through practical hands-on sessions, lectures and field trip. Meanwhile, they stressed that this kind of workshop needs to be continued in the future too. Although, participants need to apply the skills they learned during the workshop to their respective areas, the workshop met its objectives as very positive response was received from the participants on the usefulness of the workshop.
