


- The Department of Forensic Science has been established on 12th October in the year 2012. Department has being introduced under the School of Life Sciences, at present the department is running under the SoS IER. Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, (A Central University) Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh.
- The department is running UG & PG in Forensic Science with the intake of 37 & 45 Students respectively.
- The department has started Ph.D. program in Forensic Science from the academic session 2021-22.

- 07 students have got jobs of Assistant Professors in different private organizations.
- 23 students have been Qualified for FACT & FACT plus Examination-2022 conducted by the Ministry of Home affairs (MHA), Govt. of India
- 05 Students are working as Forensic Professional in CFSLs- MHA, India.






