Brief Report on Two Day National Seminar entitled,"Current Scenario of Forensic Science in Crime and Society" Oct-12,13-2023

A two-day national seminar entitled "Current Scenario of Forensic Science in Crime and Society" was organized by the Department of Forensic Science on 12th -13th October 2023. A total of 254 participants attended the seminar. The participants belong to universities of different states like Madhya Pradesh, Orissa, Bihar, Maharashtra, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh Andhra Pradesh etc. The seminar was aimed to provide the opportunity for experts in the various fields of Forensic Science to share their expertise with students as well as with law/ police personnel. The inauguration session was held on 12th October 2023.
