The department is offering a doctoral programme in Political Science. Along with the JRF, SRF, and National Fellowships scheduled by the UGC, Non-NET Fellowship is also provided by the university to support the researchers' research. After completing the Ph.D. programme researchers will be able to comprehend and exhibit their proficiency in the following areas:

PO-1: Prepare and motivate the scholars to advance their research careers beyond a doctoral degree, and pursue careers in academics. They also acquire interdisciplinary knowledge by highlighting connections between various socio-political and economic challenges.

PO-2: To make it possible for the researchers to explore and analyse the complexities of their disciplinary and academic investigation. To gain in-depth knowledge of the field in order to sharpen their academic intellectual abilities and develop a research interest.
