GENDER BASED VIOLENCE WITH CHILDREN & WOMEN IN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS AND OTHER PLACES - A SERIOUS PROBLEM

❖ ABSTRACT:

Violence against children and women is a serious problem not only in our country but in the world, In December last year, a four-year-old child at another south Kolkata school was sexually assaulted allegedly by two teachers following which angry parents protested outside the school. The two were arrested soon after. In the same month, parents of another school protested after a three-year-old child was sexually abused by a staff member twice earlier that year.

Earlier this year, a seven-year-old at a primary school in Bengal was sexually assaulted for nearly a month, allegedly by the school's security guard. The man was arrested in February 2022 after angry parents of the school's students protested at its gates

a 10-year-old schoolgirl suffered burns to 60 percent of her body when two unidentified men in the village of Jharkhand in eastern India allegedly poured kerosene on her, set her aflame, and threw her in a dry well for resisting rape

Sexual violence in India caused massive outrage in 2012, when a 23-year-old Delhi student was gang raped on a moving bus and later died in the hospital. That attack led to mass street protests over the high level of violence against women, prompting the Indian government to toughen jail sentences for rapists. Perpetrators found guilty now receive a minimum 20 years in prison, instead of the previous 10. The maximum sentence is life behind bars.

The United Nations defines violence against women as "any act of gender-based violence that results in, or is likely to result in, physical, sexual, or mental harm or suffering to women, including threats of such acts, coercion or arbitrary deprivation of liberty, whether occurring in public or in private life, during the Lockdowns COVID-19 pandemic and its social and economic impacts have increased the exposure of women to abusive partners and known risk factors, while limiting their access to services.
