The Association of Pharmaceutical Teachers of India (APTI) takes immense pleasure in honoring Dr. Dilipkumar Pal with the prestigious "APTI-Prof. LVG Nargund Research Excellence Award in Pharmaceutical Chemistry-2021" during the 25th APTICON at Mysore, Karnataka.

Dr Dilipkumar Pal born in 1971, at Panua, Bankura, West Bengal, is a B Pharm (1997), M. Pharm (1999) and Ph D (2003), all from Department of Pharmaceutical Technology, Jadavpur University, Kolkata. He performed post-doctoral research in University of Sydney, Australia. Dr Pal is now working as Associate Professor, in Department of Pharmacy, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (A Central University), Bilaspur, C.G., India.

Dr Pal has published 186 full research papers in both national and international scientific journals of repute and contributed 117 abstracts in different national and international conferences. He has written 2 books and 69 book chapters and edited 08 books published by reputed international publishers. His research publications have acquired a highly remarkable cited record: H-Index: 49; i-10-index 111, citation 7659 till date. One Patent granted and 01 Patent published by him till date. He has supervised 08 Ph D scholars and 42 M Pharm students, presently 02 aspirants are pursuing their doctoral programme under his guidance. He was procured with 02 major research projects sponsored by UGC, New Delhi.

Dr Pal in his 21 years research-oriented teaching profession received 13 prestigious national and international professional awards including Endeavour Postdoctoral Research Fellowship Award-2010 by Government of Australia; ISTE Rajalaxmi Memorial Best Technical College Teacher Award-2009 by Indian Society for Technical Education, APTI-Young Pharmacy Teacher Award-2010 by APTI, SPER Young Scientist Award-2012 by SPER at DIPSAR, New Delhi; SPER Innovative Researcher Award-2016 by Society of Pharmaceutical Education and Research. He is the Reviewer and Editorial Board member of 27 and 29 scientific journals, respectively. Dr Pal has been included in World's Top 2% Indian Scientist (sub: Pharmacy and Pharmacology) in the year 2020 and 2021 as declared by the Stanford University, USA.

Dr Pal has served apart from his present University, other academic Institutions and professional bodies in various capacities. He is the life member of 14 such professional bodies.
